Local Skills Improvement Plan (LSIP) - update from Business West

- SWLEP S&T Subgroup would provide the external governance and key role in steering further research and engagement
- Deep dives research with employers in specific sectors identified in 2022-23
- New Skills Adviser appointed for signposting to the Growth Hub in the first instance to avoid duplication
- Mapping of current skills provision to be undertaken with providers

Local Skills Improvement Fund (LSIF) - update from Wiltshire College & University Centre

- LSIF funding intended to enable FE to respond to priorities emerging from the LSIP
- Joint bid by Wiltshire College & University Centre with New College Swindon and IoT for £2.5m
- Projects include Eco House & Sustainable Technology, Tech Trowbridge, green automotive and digitalisation of logistics/distribution
- Bid outcome expected October



Careers Hub

- Continues to be one of the top performing Careers Hubs in the country
- Vast majority of Gatsby benchmarks above national averages (as per last five years)
- Renewed focus on apprenticeship opportunities this year
- Launch of the online careers platform for Electively Home Educated young people in August
