Target participant group is those who are unemployed/economically inactive and facing multiple, complex challenges and barriers

Participation is voluntary and free to users

- Support is not time constrained plans are adapted and evolved over time to meet the participant's needs



Steven (KFR)

Jo (Wiltshire Wildlife Trust)

- Re-built relationships with estranged family
- Moved out of supported housing (into his own accommodation)
- Started learning to drive
- Applied for a grant towards City & Guilds qualification
- Completed a residential training programme
- Moved into employment

- Main goal was to return to work on a full time contract
- Completed a range of conservation tasks
- Support with employability skills and to apply for jobs
- Support to address challenges in personal life, including debts
- Accepted an offer of a fulltime role in catering industry

Lucy (Inner Flame)

- Suffered from mental health issues and agoraphobia
- Intensive support from Key Worker to build confidence
- Attended a cookery course run by Madanu
- Completed a Level 2 English Course with LearnDirect
- Secured an apprenticeship which she is now fully enjoying
