AN OPEN LETTER TO BUSINESS FROM THE PRIME MINISTER

Since becoming Prime Minister, it has been my great privilege to have met with an inspiring range of British businesses. Whilst there is more to be done in the years ahead, the priority now is to deliver Brexit and provide the certainty businesses need so that the country can come together and move on.
