Dorset and Wiltshire Fire and Rescue service

- Merged in 2016
- 50 fire stations- 24 in Wiltshire, 26 in Dorset
- **80%** of fire engines are on call, the rest are wholetime



How does being on call work?

- 5 weeks of basic training, 2 years of development
- Respond to same incidents as wholetime
- Live as normal whilst being on call



How can businesses help?

- We need more on call firefighters!
Especially during the day
- All on call firefighters need employers' permission
- There is a chance of disruption but it is minimal
