Why?

5.8m SMEs registered at Companies House, with 563,000 in the South-West alone

59% of businesses have experienced skills shortages

Cyber security is not an option

39% of businesses and 26% of charities have reported cyber security breaches or attacks between April 2020 to March 2021*

Corporate Suites

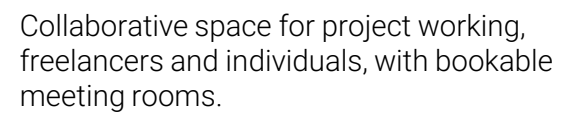

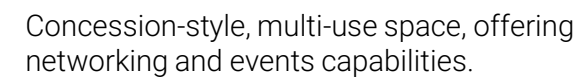
