


FY 2022/23 Q1 KPI Performance

FY 2022/23 Planned Activity

- Completion of Growth Hub independent evaluation and GH Impact Report, aiming for late July publication
- Avoid retracting Growth Hub business support services
- ERDF SME Competitiveness advantage of June 2023 completion with frontline Business Navigators
- Continuation of Digital, Skills and Green Economy as 'specialist' support areas
- Whilst not a funding requirement, continuing delivering business intelligence reports
- Don't have funding available to fund a specific Green Economy role, however, upskilling Business Navigator(s)
- Mobilisation of Growth Hub+ (pay-for) business support services with physical direct delivery commencing in August, exclusive digital portal access to follow in the autumn
- B2B/P services developing with partnership organisations such as Swindon Borough Council and Chambers
- Expression of interest being submitted to DCMS Create Growth Programme, appetite to form an English side of Western Gateway approach
