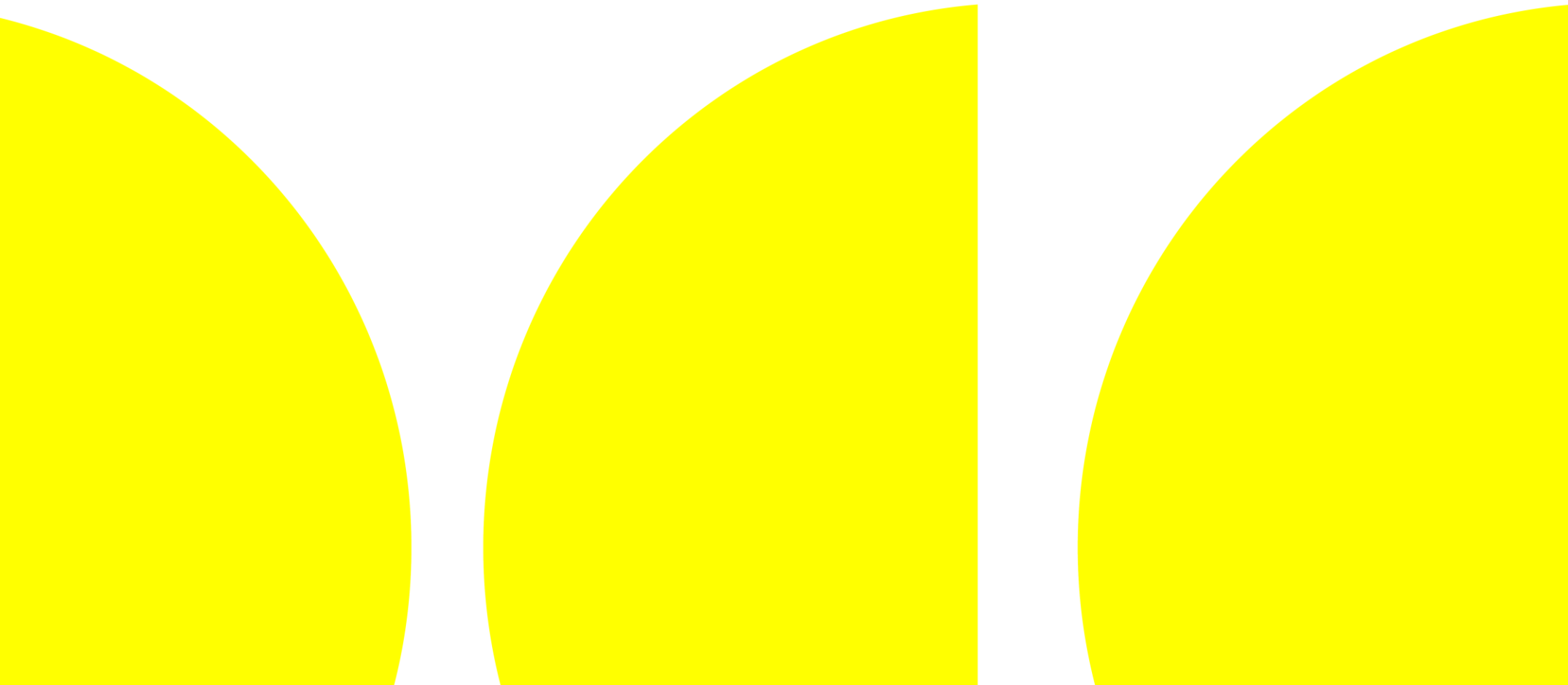

BCC Impact – 2021-22

- > £3.7 million spent or committed to companies across Swindon & Wiltshire (23%), the South West (71%) and nationally (6%)
- > At least 55 jobs retained in the construction industry
- > 3 new jobs created
- > Project completed in 6 months, 12 days



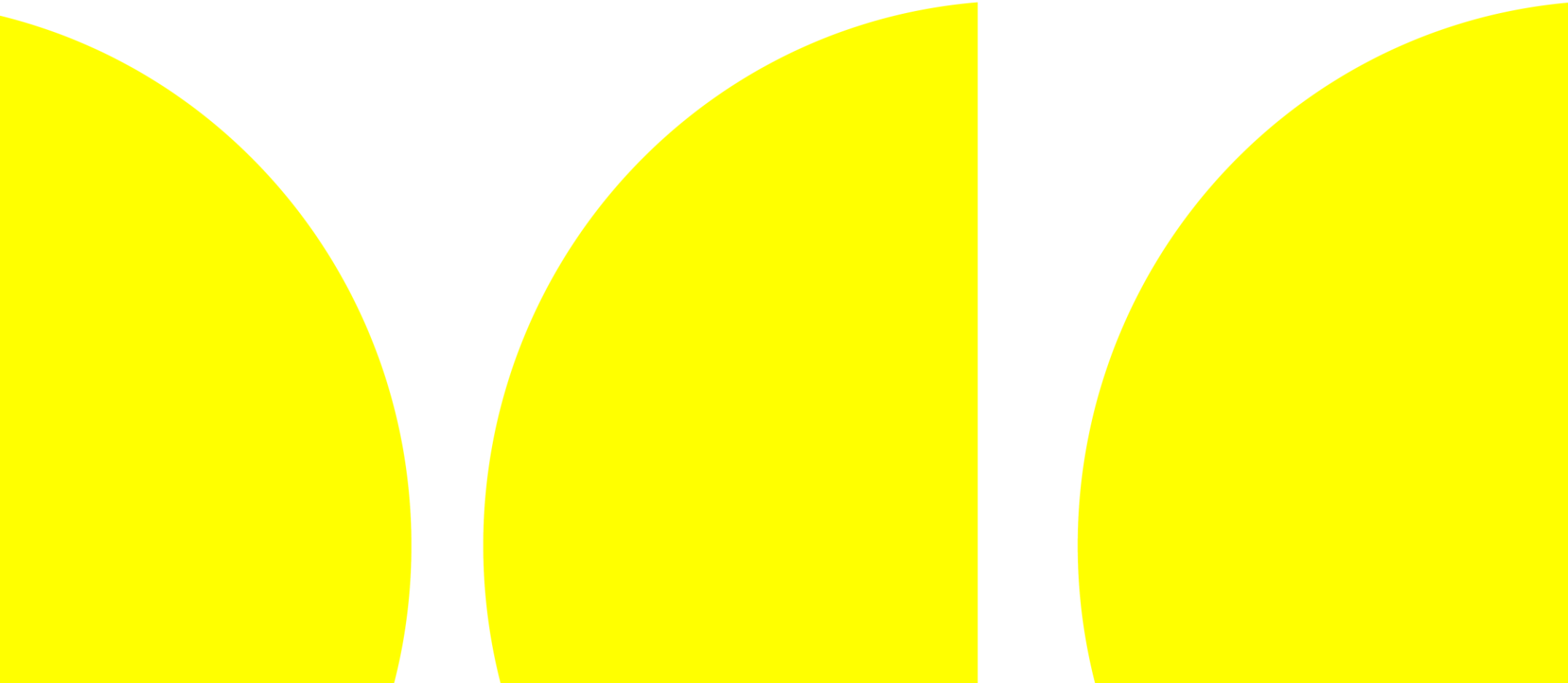
Swindon & Wiltshire Cyber Cluster
