

BCC Impact - 2021-22

- →£3.7 million spent or committed to companies across Swindon & Wiltshire (23%), the South West (71%) and nationally (6%)
- → At least 55 jobs retained in the construction industry
- ⊳3 new jobs created
- Project completed in 6 months, 12 days


