


This fully funded programme brings similar business cohorts together to build stronger leaders and strengthen business performance




Chart 14: Participant age bracket

● LEP Area ● National average




Chart 16: Participants with a physical or mental health condition

● LEP Area ● National average





Chart 15: Participant gender
