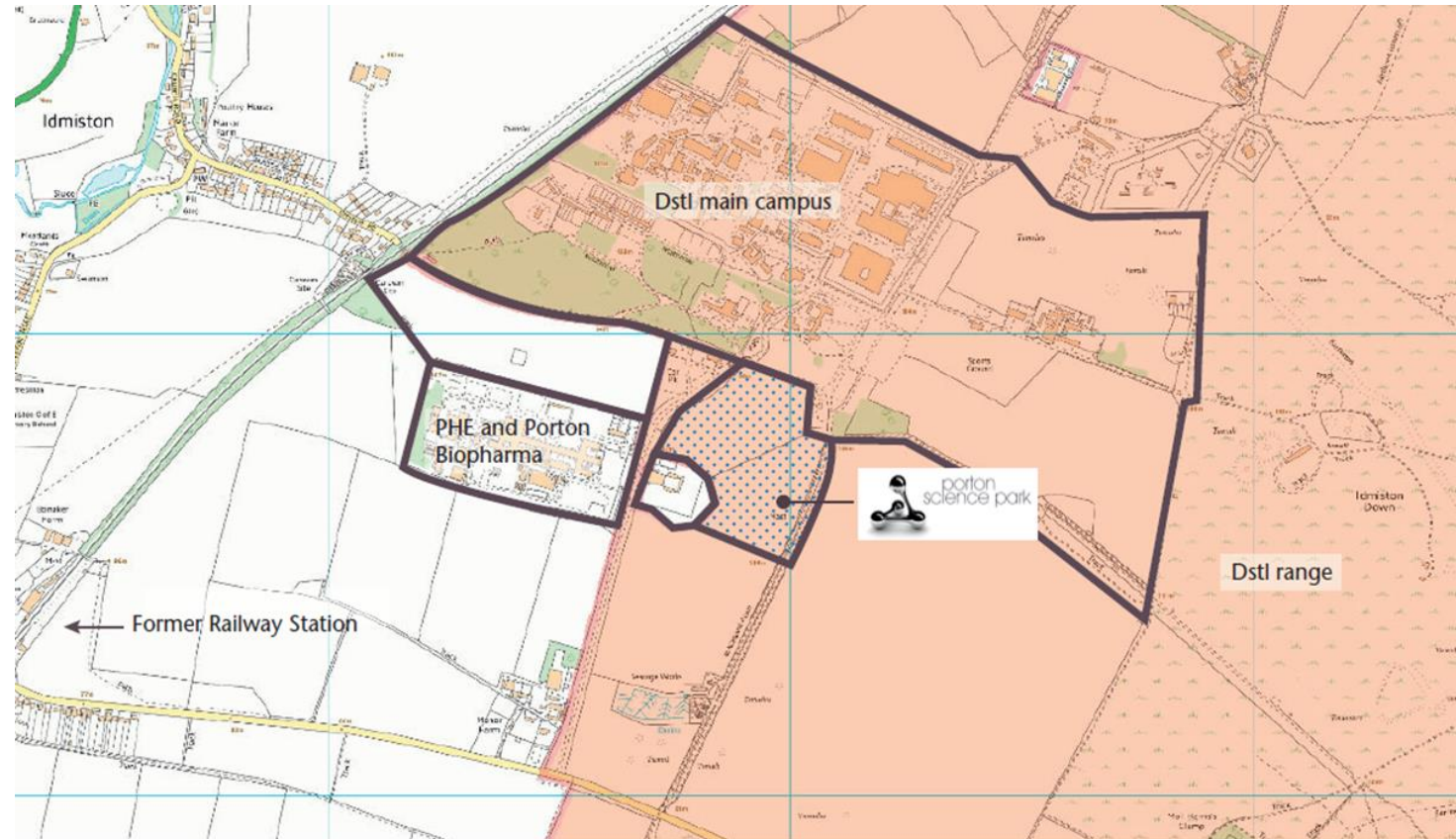

The Porton Science Campus



- Dstl
 - 2,800 ha overall extent
 - C. 4,000 staff
- UKHSA (formerly PHE)
 - 27 ha main site
 - C. 700 staff
 - VTF
- PSP
 - 10 ha main site
 - Potential for 33,000 sq.m.
 - Phase 1 incubator – 200 jobs
 - Phase 2 in delivery

Porton Science Park – phase 2: The Collaboration and Innovation Centre



- Phase 2 building
 - 3,716 sqm of laboratory, office, meeting, conferencing and grow-on space
 - £5m Council funding
 - £2.5m ERDF
 - £2m Getting Building Funding
 - Work commenced July 21
 - Handover expected September



Business support



- Successful Programme for Phase 1
70+ businesses supported –
H&LS focus]
 - ERDF funded
 - 20 completely new to market products
- Phase 2 – on-going programme
 - Workshops H&LS and Defence Technologies
 - 1 year programme
 - Target 60 SMEs
 - Via sector specific conferences, workshops and 1 to 1 support
