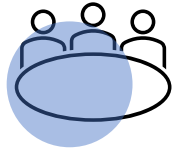
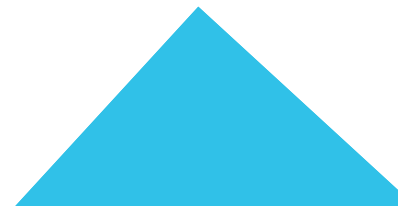

- Transition to Net Zero – Gov and industry to collaborate and invest.



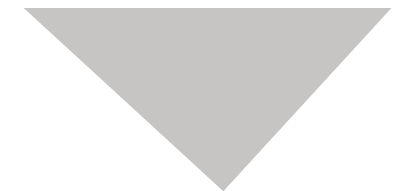
- Planning – A planning system that integrates infrastructure & logistics.

So what will the Steering Group do?

Purpose – Keep the government up to date with what is happening within this industry, what is stopping it growing and what can be done to facilitate growth, innovation, and new jobs in this space. **All with an eye on 2050!**

Long term aspiration – Be thought provoking and disruptive to gather intelligence and share ideas for members of both houses who take an interest in freight and logistics. We will also gather views from industry and regional governments and ALB on what can be done to in this space to stimulate economic growth with regions (levelling up) and to **make the UK competitive** on the international stage.

Short term (next 06 months) – Establish a Project team to determine criteria to interview 10 countries to see what they do well here and what headaches they have with logistical connectivity with the UK. We will also do a very short report of any changes 12 months since the Vision Launch.
