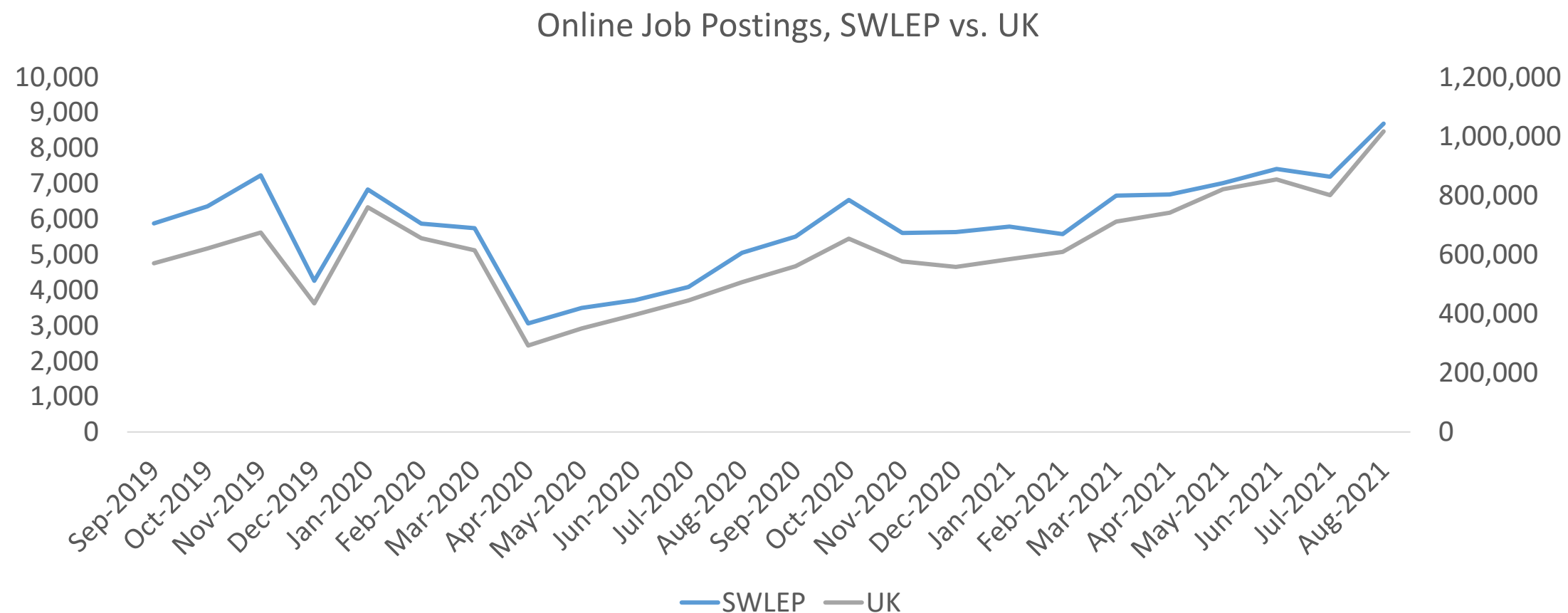

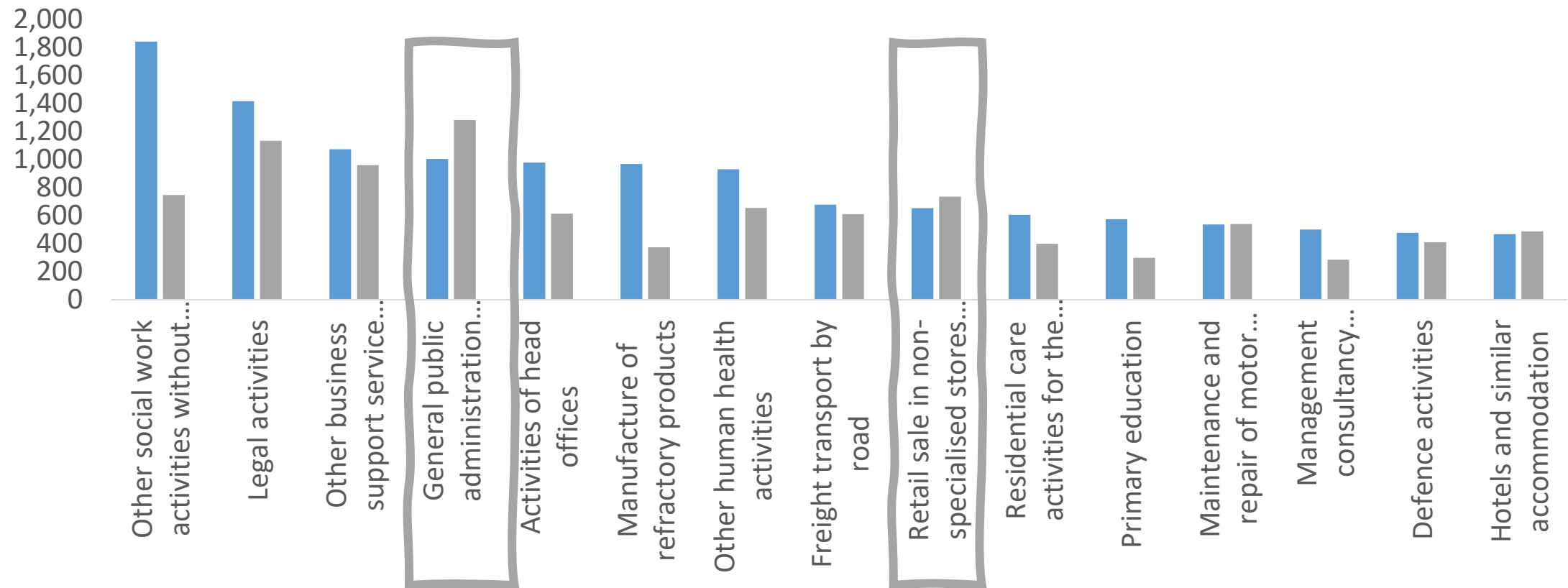


# Online job postings continue to recover



# Only two of the top 15 industries declined compared to the same period before COVID-19

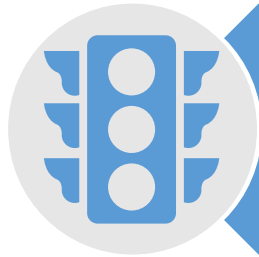
SWLEP, Top 15 Industries, Sep'20-Sep'21 vs. Sep'18-Sep'19

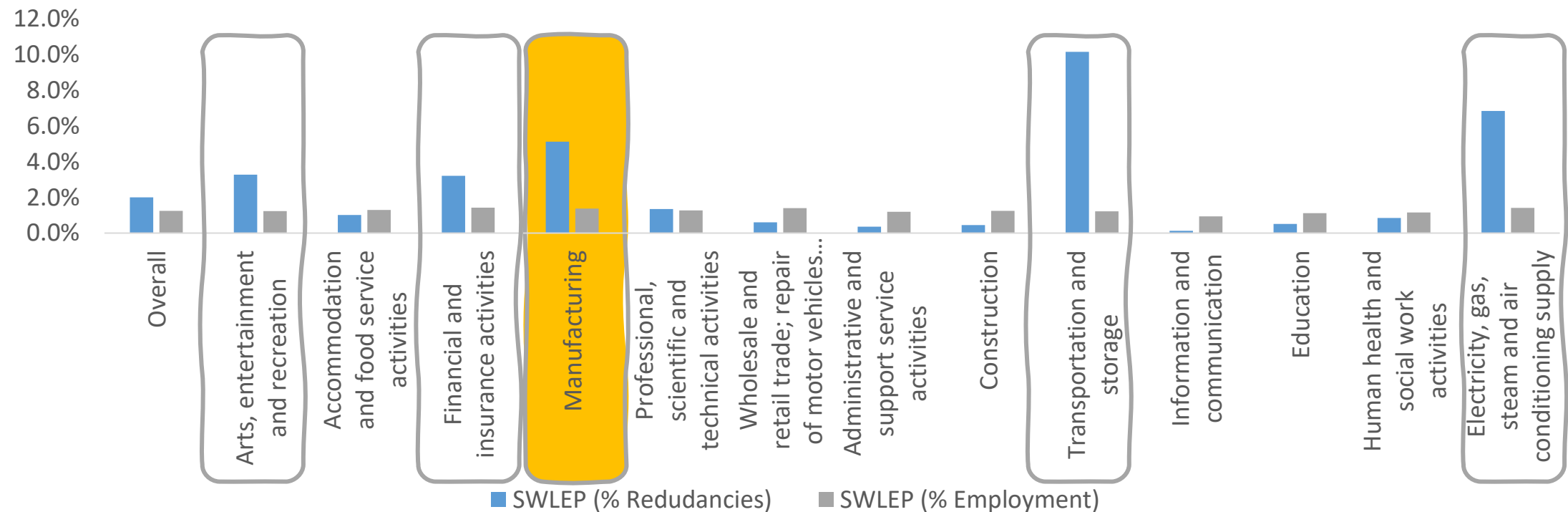

# We continue to monitor four Swindon & Wiltshire sectors showing larger than expected redundancies

SWLEP HR1 Redundancies, Jun'20-Jul'21 (% Total) vs. Employment (% Total)



- Last month there were 4 sectors with higher redundancies: Utilities, Finance and Arts & entertainment (which can at least in part be explained by the larger proportion of companies with 250+ employees), as well as Transportation & storage
- From Jul'21, we have a 5<sup>th</sup> sector with larger proportion of redundancies than employment: Manufacturing

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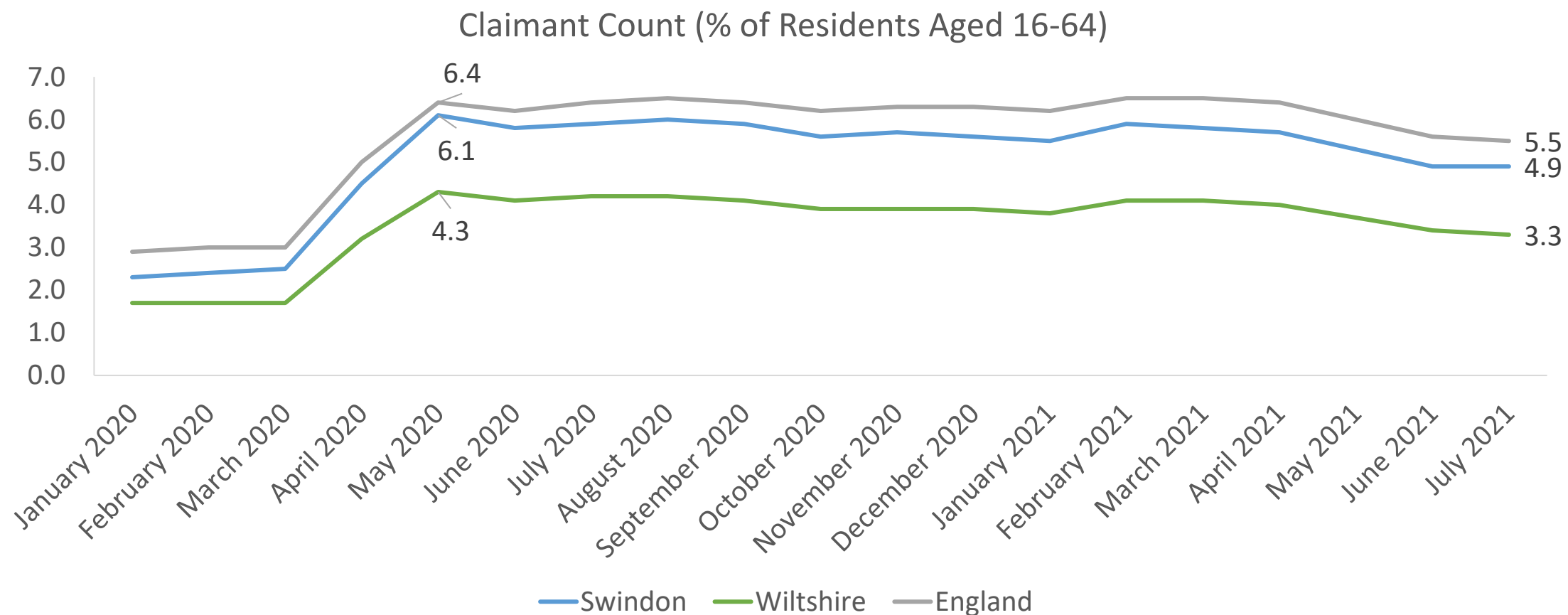

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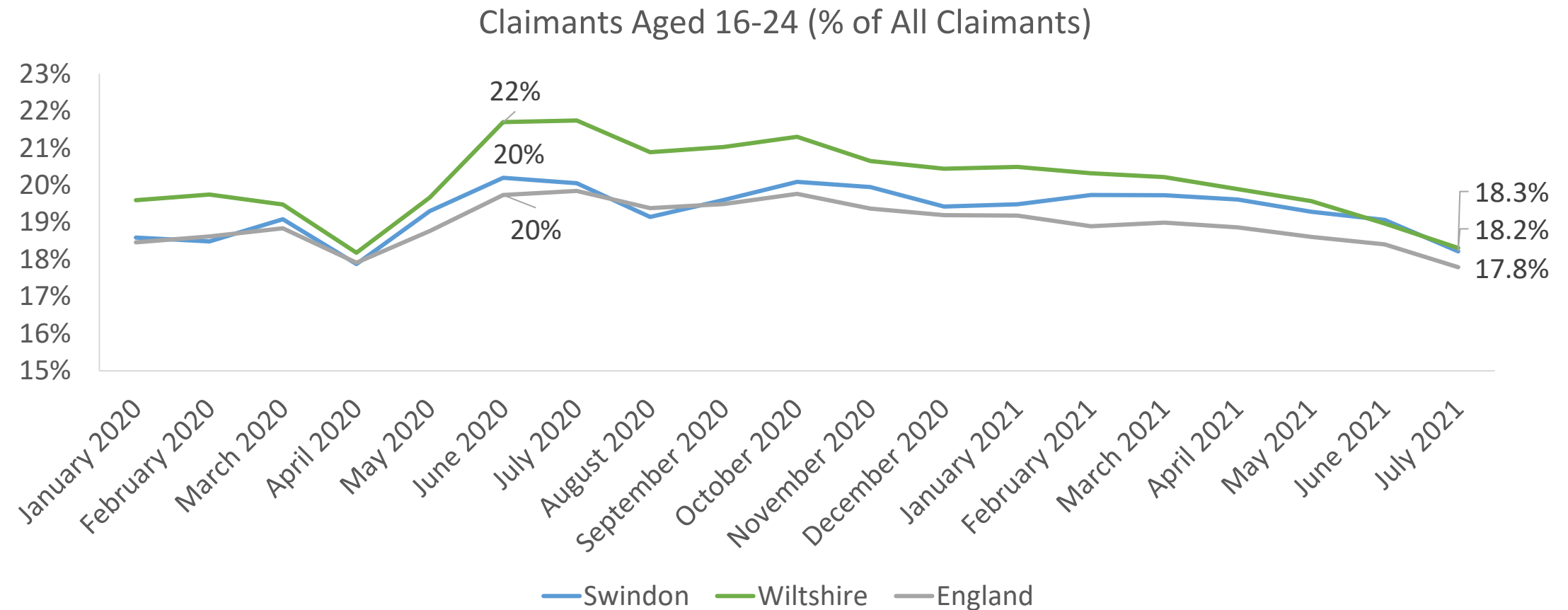


# Claimant count continues to decline across the country





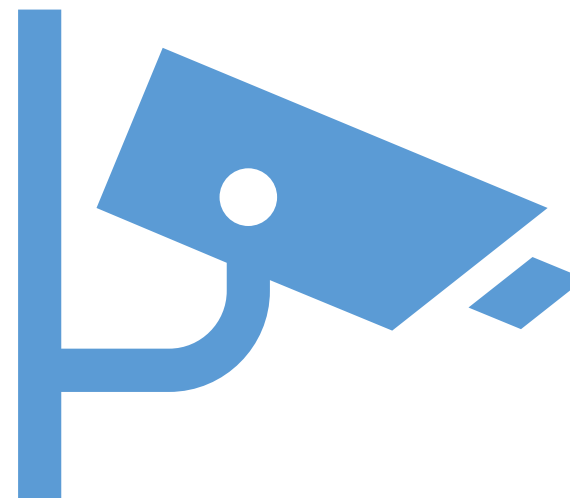
# Wiltshire's young claimants continue to decline, now better than Swindon's and only 0.5% higher than England's
