




This time last year we were seeing very slow recovery in job postings

#### SWLEP Weekly Job Postings, Jan - Jul 2020





### Apprenticeship postings across the UK are now above 2019 levels, although SWLEP remains behind




## Both SWLEP & UK continued to see improvements in the number of job postings during Jun'21

Job Postings, SWLEP vs. UK, Jan'12-Jun'21




## All of the largest occupations have been increasing job postings







## Malmesbury has seen the greatest growth rate and Swindon number increase compared to last year

Swindon & Wiltshire Job Postings - Top 10 Towns, Number of Postings vs. Year-on-Year Growth




#### Malmesbury growth driven mainly by Dyson








## HR1 data gives an indication of future redundancies at larger organisations






## The number of redundancies across the country has been declining



## We continue to monitor four Swindon & Wiltshire sectors showing larger than expected redundancies

SWLEP HR1 Redundancies Jun'20 - May'21 vs. Employment



SWLEP has larger proportion of companies with 250+ employees in Utilities sectors and slightly larger in Finance and Arts & entertainment, which could explain the differences, but not in Transportation & storage






## Although Wiltshire's number of young work-related claimants is improving, Swindon's rate remains elevated...

#### **ONLINE POSTINGS**

- SWLEP Jun'21 job postings considerably above Jun'19 levels, more so than UK
- SWLEP apprenticeship behind 2019 levels and recovering slower than the UK average



#### HR1 DATA

- SWLEP broadly in line with the national average
- Four sectors worse than expected: Transportation & storage; Utilities; Arts, entertainment and recreation; Financial and insurance activities



#### **CLAIMANT COUNT**

- As proportion of population aged 18-24, Wiltshire's work-related claimants are below the national average
- Although, not as low as other age groups
