



- Wiltshire College and University Centre started to develop a virtual work experience platform in 2020 to provide students with opportunities during the pandemic.










Funding Bid Applications

Ahead of the Game Transitions Fund: £20,000 allocated to provide up to 1,000 personal guidance interviews to up to 250 young people RoN/NEET. Delivered by Adviza between July and December.

Effective Transitions Fund – bid submitted to support 100 year 10s in a 2 year programme to a positive destination in year 12. Bid unsuccessful.

Hub Incubation Project – £70,000 allocated to deliver a maths based careers programme to years 7s in 10 x schools to prevent maths anxiety in female students.
