Considerations:

- Taking into account what the Skills Builders Partnership & the CEC are delivering, identify what is missing?
- What is the pitch into schools? What is it that will inspire? What needs to be produced? Resources?
 - Research is required to answer this! (what is the correct messaging & detailed activity needed?)
- Need to change perceptions of routes to public sector leadership (alternatives to university)
- Show that social action can lead to careers either direct hire, apprenticeships or graduate routes
- Offer practical opportunities to engage with the local community? TS Challenge? (with universities?)
