





Working alongside the Trowbridge Place Board helped WCUC contribute as a major partner in ongoing work to redevelop and revitalise the town.

Partnerships so far have helped realise...

- Investment into creating a digital Tech Hub at the Trowbridge campus, featuring a livestreaming & broadcast arena and hirable spaces for business.
- Sponsored by local businesses -Generation of an outdoor gallery featuring 30 individual artworks for a walkway during the first stage of the Innox Mills redevelopment.









Electric Vehicle Workshop

- Project expanded to include additional space
- 325 sq m development with 4 vehicle bays and full electric vehicle rigs
- Proposed to deliver minimum 3 new courses
 levels 2, 3 and 4 Technical Specialist in
 Electric Vehicle
- Ground clearance underway with full construction to begin April/May 24









Construction and Built Environment

- Project to upgrade facilities to support provision of new, sustainable construction courses.
- Courses include:
 - Solar thermal hot water systems
 - Smart metering
 - Ground source heat pumps
- Work includes refurbishment of existing buildings, civils lab, and concrete testing facility.





Logistics and warehousing

- Revenue only project to engage with sector and establish need.
- New warehousing qualifications launched (first group Feb 24) for new entrants to the sector.
