Hub Incubation Project: Maths Evaluation Outcomes

Did the project have a positive impact on girls' maths anxiety?

For students who reported higher maths anxiety at the start of the project (81% female), there was a statistically significant reduction in maths anxiety over the course of the project.

For the female students in the higher anxiety group, there was a decrease in maths anxiety across every question.

Did the project increase girls' interest in maths-related careers?

Maths is useful in lots of jobs:
Increase from 25% to 36%
Maths is useful in creative jobs:
Increase from 54% to 62%
There are lots of maths-based careers in Swindon and Wiltshire:
Increase from 84% to 88%
I am interested in a maths-based career:
Decrease from 21% to 17%










Teacher Encounters Fund
