



Hub Incubation Projects – Updates

HIP 1: To undertake a Hub Incubation Research Project on embedding employer encounters into year 7 maths curriculum:

8 projects are currently underway with 7 schools.

A range of sessions have been delivered including employer site visits for students.

Evaluation activities are about to be undertaken with all stakeholders.

Final report with resource pack, scale up plan and comms is due early September 2022.



Hub Incubation Projects – Updates

HIP 2: Does the provision of appropriate resources for parents/carers, increase the overall career readiness of electively home educated (EHE) young people.

Resources will be co-created and tested by EHE parents/carers over a 12 month period, with input from young people.

A resource bank site will be created to allow EHE parents/carers to self-select support they need individually to develop a careers programme as part of their curriculum.

Project value: £70,000
