What is Multiply?

- First phase of the **UK shared prosperity fund** under the skills for life agenda
- Reporting into the DFE
- Wiltshire council has been allocated **£2.108 million** over 3 years
- **Aim:** upskill adults (19+) who don't have a level 2 maths qualification
- **Delivery:** range of interventions which can be planned against, e.g. upskilling and removing barriers to progression in work, supporting specific groups such as offenders and care leavers, support for ESOL etc.
